- Selected poems both in English and Nepali shall be recited in the presence of acclaimed litterateurs of the country on Friday, December 9, 2022 (Mangsir 23, 2079)
- Winners shall be declared just after the recitation. Prize distribution including presentation of trophies shall be held on the same day.
- In case of any dispute, the decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final.
- Dress code: All participants need to be in either formal or institutional attire during the program
